








1.Unfold the chair

Remove all packing materials from the chair. Pull up on the backrest to unfold the chair to an upright position, ensure the backrest has been locked into the place







2.Attach the backrest pad

Attach the backrest pad flap to the top of the backrest. Smooth the two bottom flaps under the bottom of the backrest. All flaps attach using velcro.

3.Attach the seat pad

Place the seat pad into position, and press down firmly to attach it using the velcro. Tuck one of the seat pad side flaps between the seat and the armrest. Pull firmly on the flap, wrap it around the chair frame, then attach it to the chair frame using the velcro. Repeat this procedure to attached the other side flap to the chair frame.


4. Attach the manicure trays

Slide the new manicure tray mounting plate into position. Secure the mounting plate with the two screws supplied. A Philips head screwdriver is required.




5.Attach the pillow

Fix the pillow by velcro



6.Power on

Plug the power cord into a grounded power source with GFCI (class A)




7.Adjust the backrest


Use the remote control to position the backrest at a desired angle.

Bottom Frame And Backrest Installation



- The first step is to secure the bottom frame onto the spa tub by matching the bottom frame holes to the predrilled holes in the spa base, secure with 4 nuts/washers/bolts
- Align the protruding pins on the lower sides of the chair back with the locking hooks on the sides of the bottom frame; and the hooks on the bottom of the chair back need to align with the pins of the hydraulic motor beneath the seat frame. Attach the chair back by engaging all three hooks and pins.





Arm And Tray Installation




 Put down the tray board and use a screw driver to adjust the screw; then gently push the arm forward.

Insert Pin(inside of arm) into socket Screw at base of chair and secure with screw Pin remote control remote control holder manicure tray -wood arm purse hook

Back Recline And Seat Movement




- The seat's movement is operated on an electric hydraulic system and has a "120mm" extension range
- The chair's reclining mechanism reaches from 100 degrees to 120 degrees, relative to base and is operated on an electric hydraulic system




PCB and Seat Cushion Installation



- Remove the box's screws and unplug its wires, then Remove the PCB carefully.
- Attention: Only licensed electricians are permitted to access, and repair the PCB box and components.




The seat cushion is fixed to the seat frame by steel brackets and Velcro.

MASSAGE TECHNIQUES

Massage Techniques	What It Does	Benefits	
PERCUSSION	Alternates rapid-tapping strokes along the spine to stimulate both spinal muscles and spinal joint areas, emulating the percussive massage technique used in sports medicine for deep muscle therapy.	Flexes spinal joints and relieves pressure on the spinal column, invigorating the entire back area.	
COMPRESSION	Presses on spinal muscles and spinal joint areas using alternating strokes and a gentle rocking motion, emulating a technique used in sports medicine and in spinal therapy by chiropractors.	Spreads and applies pressure to deep muscle tissue, forcing it to relax, while the rocking motion loosens spinal joints. Aides in muscle and joint repair due to strain from exercise,long hours bent over a desk, or just day-to-day stress, and can improve mobility and overall posture.	
KNEADING	Kneads your back in a small, circular motion on both sides of your spine simultaneously.	Relieves tension and soreness by lifting and stretching muscles. Improves circulation and helps bring vital nutrients to the spinal area.	
ROLLING	Rolls gently up and down your back near your spine	Warms and loosens your muscles, preparing your back for deeper massage Relieves muscle tension, improves circulation and relaxes the back.

Maintenance And Precaution



Before using

- 1.Read the entire manual carefully before operating your True Touch® chair
- 2. Assemble your product correctly by following the instructions in the manual
- 3.Ensure the main power switch(bottom of chair back to the side) is set to "Off" before connecting the power cord to the electrical outlet

Familiarizing Processes

- 1.Do not run the massage chair too long on the first use (break-in period)
- 2.If too much pressure is felt from the massage heads and is causing discomfort, place a thick blanket or towel behind the chair user to reduce the pressure

Prolonging the life of massage chair

The rated working time of this machine is 30 minutes. To prolong the life of the machine, power-down for 10 minutes every time it has been working continuously for 30 minutes.

After using

Turn off the chair's power after each massage/use Main Power



Storage and working conditions

- 1.Do not place chair in direct sunlight
- 2.Do not place chair next to a heater
- 3. This chair is designed for indoor use only. Do not use outdoors.
- 4.Do not use the chair where there is excessive dust, oil, smoke and/or caustic gas. (voc)

Protection of the massage chair

- 1.Do not put any items, including hands, between the massage system and massage system components, especially when the machine is operating.
- 2.Do not drop, push, or place any objects into any slot, hole, or opening of the machine
- 3. To avoid damage, do not jump on the seat, back, or any other part of the chair

Repair

Do not assemble or disassemble the chair yourself, If there is any damage to the wire or the plug, please contact the dealer for maintenance or repair.




Cleaning

Do not clean the massage chair with thinners such as ethanol or gasoline; abrasive and/or corrosive chemicals.

Others

- 1. If you need to move the massage chair between places with large temperature variances, please ensure that the massage chair has been stopped working for at least one hour before moving.
- 2. Please switch the massage chair off and pull the plug out of the wall receptacle immediately if you feel anything abnormal while it is functionting, then consult the local dealer for maintenance or repair.
- 3. Please stop the massage chair and consult your doctor if you feel pain.
- 4. The chair main power must be turned off when not in use and/or at end of the day.





	Do not use it when voltage does not meet with standard.
\bigcirc	Do not soak or submerge the remote control in any liquid.
	Do not drop or push anything into any slot or opening in the massage chair or its components
	Do not use it in wet condition such as bathroom, swimming pool, or spa.
	Do not place chair next to heater
	Do not pull the plug forcefully or hold the plug with wet hands.
\bigcirc	Do not use it when its outer cover is broken. In this case the cover should be replaced.
•	This product is to be connected to a branch circuit outlet protected by a Class A GROUND FAULT CIRCUIT INTERRUPTER (GFCI), and the GFCI shall be tested regularly for continued protection and correct operation. 0	Ensure the power button is set to the Off position before plugging the chair into the electrical outlet.
0	Be sure to turn the power off the chair and unplug the power cord from the wall receptacle when the machine is not in use.
0	Do not forget to pull the plug out of the wall receptacle whenever there is a power cut to avoid unforeseeable accident.
0	This appliance should only be used with an experienced professional at hand or by a person with knowledge or experience with the equipment, unless they have given supervision or instruction concerning use of appliance by a person responsible for their safety. Children should be supervised to ensure that they don't play with the appliance.
